Visits

FOCUS ON WASTE MANAGEMENT



May has become a month of open doors for the Waste Management Facility (WMF) and the company as a whole. Among the delegates are deputies of the Maslikhat of the city of Atyrau, as well as representatives of NCOC N.V., environmental NGOs, government agencies and universities. All of them visited the WMF for the first time. After visiting the site, the delegations praised both the production processes and the level of openness West Dala LLP has to the public.

It is worth noting that West Dala is collaborating with NCOC N.V. since 2007. Within the framework of the partnership, various tasks are being solved for the integrated waste

management of the Western Eskene Project and the Bautino Base. The visit to the WMF was organized so that public activists of the city could personally get acquainted with the waste management processes of NCOC N.V. waste.

Among the delegates were technologists and environmentalists who asked professional questions about the operation of equipment, emissions and all processes for managing oil waste. They noted that they are interested in the process of recycling such waste, as they have a great impact on the environment, and West Dala is becoming an important center in this matter between oil companies and environmental well-being.

The deputies of the Maslikhat of the new convocation were also interested in the state of the waste management industry in the region from the point of view of ecology. After the crisis in Atyrau in early April, when a thick smog covered the city, the deputies visited industrial facilities, including the West Dala LLP.

At the WMF, the deputies were shown the chain of integrated management at the facility: how waste is received, how waste is sorted, industrial effluents and liquid waste are treated;

environmentally safe high-temperature disposal of waste; waste neutralization; waste demercurization; processing of chemical liquid and solid waste, food, medical and other types of waste. Having visited the WMF, the deputies noted the high level of organization of work at the facility, the cleanliness of the territory and compliance with sanitary standards.

In turn, representatives of the West Dala company voiced to the deputies the problematic issues of the industry related to construction waste, glass waste, batteries and other waste. Also during the meeting, it was noted that currently in the region there is an unprofessional handling of medical waste by some unscrupulous companies, which harms the ecology of the region.

HIGH SCORE IN CHESM AND CSW

In May, the results of the annual CHESM audit, which took place in April among Tengizchevroil (TCO) contractors, were announced. The audit was aimed at reviewing the processes of managing health, safety and environmental issues. According to the results of the CHESM audit, West Dala was awarded the category "A" with the highest score: for intermediate results – 97%, final score – 96%. West Dala LLP has been highly rated in CHESM for four years. This total is the result of teamwork and hard work of all West Dala employees on the project. The Company will continue to follow TCO's health, safety and

environmental requirements on a daily basis.

HR AUDIT WITH AN EXCELLENT MARK

In April, the audit of West Dala HR documentation on compliance with the requirements of the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Policies and Procedures of the company was completed. The audit was carried out by

the services of NCOC, which has been our partner for several years. During the audit, labor regulations, job descriptions, contracts and other documents were evaluated. The number of points scored in the audit was 98% of

the total 100% of the assessment of compliance with the labor legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan. According to the approved table, such a result is assessed as "excellent".

STANDARDS

CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

West Dala LLP once again confirmed its compliance with the requirements of international standards ISO 9001:2015, ISO 14001:2015, ISO 45001:2018, having successfully passed an audit by an independent certified body Intertek. This time the audit was conducted at a facility in the Mangistau region. "During April, a large-scale inspection took place in all areas of the company's activities.

During the audit, no discrepancies were found, and in many respects a mature and developed approach to work was noted," comments Asem Sarsengaliyeva, ISM Manager, on the results of the audit. She also noted that such results can only be achieved if all the principles of quality management and the involvement of all personnel are applied.

TRANSITION TO A GREEN ECONOMY

initiatives aimed at improving the environment and transition to green energy.



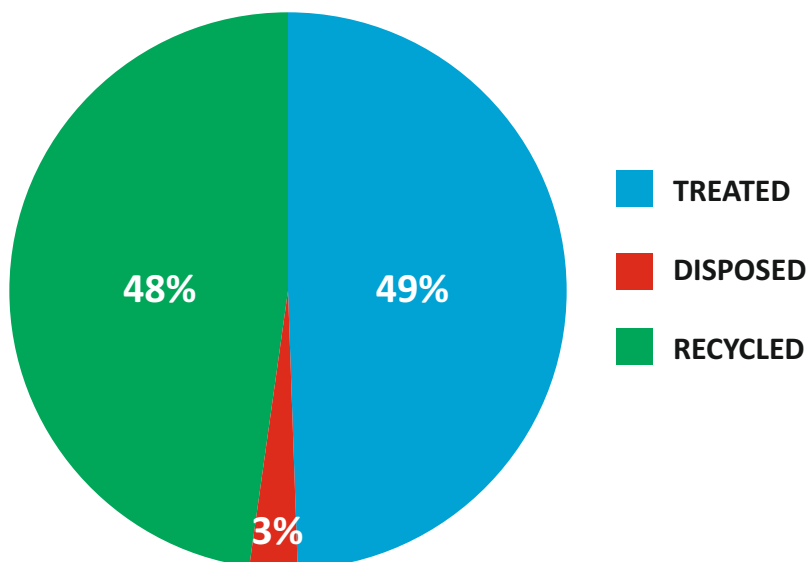
HIGH LEVEL OF RECYCLING

West Dala LLP accepts all types of waste, including hazardous and non-hazardous. According to environmentalists, in the first half of 2023, the company processed 49% of waste in the Atyrau

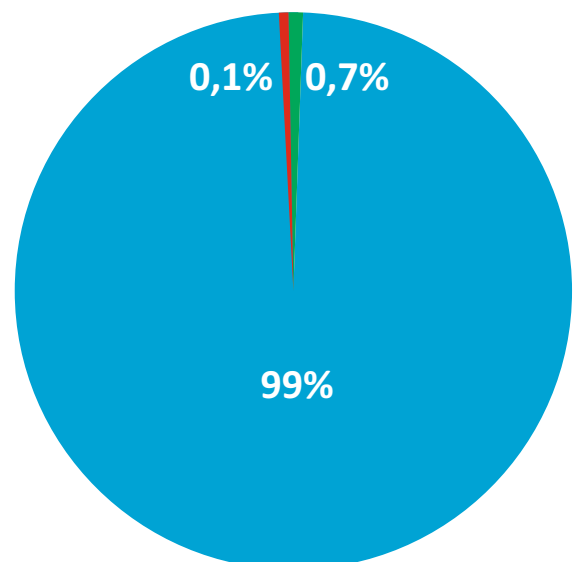
region, while 48% of all waste received at waste management facilities was transferred. It is important to note that 3% of all waste is disposed. Excellent results in the Mangistau region, where

99% of all waste is recycled. It is important to note that when handling waste, all the conditions of the current legislation were observed.

INDUSTRY

FORUM ASKS THE QUESTIONS



On July 4-5, in Astana, the Kazakhstan Waste Management Association "KazWaste" with the support of the Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources of the Republic of Kazakhstan held the VII Eurasian Business Forum "Green Energy and Waste Recycling 2023".

GEWR'23 brought together more than 200 experts and representatives of government agencies, businesses from Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, Kyrgyzstan, Great Britain, Latvia, Germany and the USA on one platform. Representatives of West Dala participated in plenary sessions and round tables to discuss the circular economy in the global ESG agenda, the importance of developing "sustainable" cities, electronic waste, the formation of a civilized market for secondary raw materials, the development of SMEs in the field of waste management, innovative technological solutions for the collection and recycling, transition to IEP and NAT, as well as in the National Methane Forum.

On the eve of the business forum, representatives of West Dala visited Astana waste recycling enterprises. The delegates of the forum showed their production to STI Company LLP for tire recycling, ECOMAF LLP and ZQ 2021 LLP for recycling plastic waste into finished products. During the forum, the problems faced by all processors of the

country, as well as ways to solve them, were discussed. Among them are the development of such necessary measures as the development of standards and the introduction of procedures for confirming the conformity of secondary raw materials and products, as well as measures to stimulate the development of this market. One of the main theses: waste is a renewable resource. But at this stage, this approach is missing both due to low support from the state, and from the understanding of the importance of waste recycling on the part of the population. Despite the presence of advanced international experience, changing attitudes towards waste will take years, although the situation requires decisions now.

Within the framework of the forum, the initiatives of the KAZWASTE association were announced: the creation of the Circular Economy Committee under the National ESG Club. The Committee will help accelerate the transition of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the principles of a circular economy, disseminate best practices, and promote approaches to creating business ecosystems for the efficient use of resources. It is also planned to create a Technical Committee for Standardization "Circular Economy. Sustainable production and consumption", which will improve the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan on the circular economy, implement pilot projects together with members of the Committee and the ESG Club. In general, the forum has become a platform for discussing topical issues of the industry. In this regard, it is important to note the efforts of KAZWASTE, which is celebrating its 10th anniversary this year. The association team actively promotes the transition of enterprises to the sustainable development of the waste processing business, and in general, thanks to the work of the association, a noticeable development of the waste management industry in Kazakhstan over the past decade can be noted.

At the awards ceremony as part of the 10th anniversary of the KAZWASTE Association, West Dala was awarded the medal "For Contribution to the Development of the Waste Management Industry".
